Air Doc Manual

What Is It All About?

You can use Air Doc to transfer documents, movies, web addresses, screenshots or your system clipboard to your iPad or your iPhone. All documents that can be shown (pdf, movies, songs,...) are opened immediately for viewing.

Use cases:

- use it as a turbocharged second display for your Mac
- transfer your documents fast and easy just by dropping them
- when you transferred your documents, you can open them in any App on your iOS device (e.g. GoodReader, Mail,...)
- simply drop a web url and it will immediately open in a browser on your iOS device
- use it to distribute handouts without the need for email, iTunes or any cloud space - fast and easy
- drop movies to watch them on your iOS device and take them with you, even stream your movies using AirPlay
- store recently transferred files on your iOS device for later viewing (without the need for any network access)

All you need is the Air Doc Viewer App on your iPad or iPhone and the free Air Doc App from the Mac App Store.

Installation

Installation is as simple as downloading the Apps from the App Store. Your devices must be in the same LAN for your Mac to discover your iPad/iPhone. No need for additional setup, everything is configured using Bonjour/ZeroConf network functions.

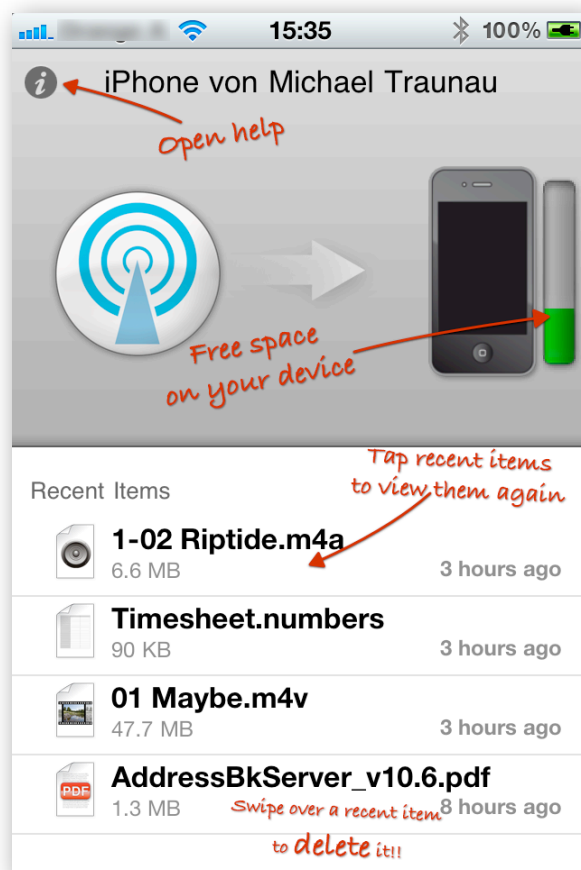
What About Air Doc on my Mac?



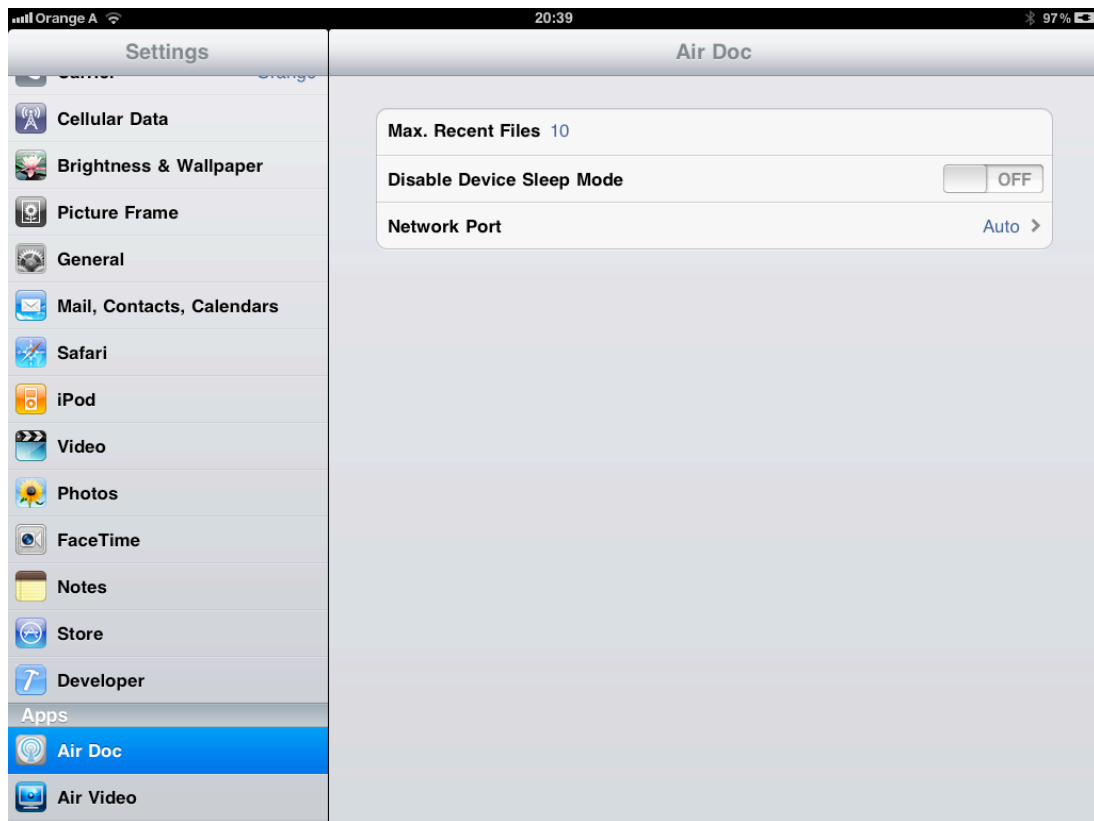
Start the App on your Mac and on your iOS devices. Everything is configured for you, just start dragging files into the iOS device symbol and they will be shown on your iPad or iPhone.

The hotkeys (Cmd+Alt+V for pasting content to your iOS device and Cmd+Alt+S for taking a screenshot and showing it on your iOS device) are globally active on your system. Activate them wherever you want, as long as the App is running.

What about the iOS App?



Settings on your iOS device



Max Recent Files: how much files are stored in your recent list? The oldest file will be deleted.

Disable Device Sleep Mode: our iOS device will not switch off the screen while running Air Doc

Network Port: Air Doc uses a random port, but if you got network connection problems, switch to a fixed port
